Regional Employment Trials (RET) Initiative - Tech Micro-credentials and 'Code-a-Job' Hackathons across the Illawarra.

Announcing a programme of events targeting job-seekers which includes 5 Online Tech Micro-credentials training short courses in Coding, Cloud, Web Development, AgTech (Agriculture) and Artificial Intelligence, and additionally, 3 Hackathons at the population centres of Bega, Batemans Bay and Nowra.

Building on a successful rollout of the Regional Employment Trials programme in 2019, 2pi Software is introducing a new approach to employability skills acquisition for job-seekers in Bega, Bateman's Bay, Nowra and outlying rural/remote areas. Focussing on online delivery of high value digital skills, unemployed people facing transport and other challenges, can take advantage of learning opportunities tailored to their needs that would previously be difficult to access.

Thanks to grant funding from the Australian Government as part of its **Regional Employment Trials (RET)** initiative, the 2pi Software programme will kick off on the 28th March with the **Code-a-job Hackathon** at the University of Wollongong Campus in Batemans Bay - an exciting day of creativity and learning designed to stimulate an interest in digital technology that may lead to future career opportunities. While the event will primarily encourage those currently not in a job to join in, all members of the public wishing to learn more about code, the cloud, the web and even apps for mobile devices, should register to take part.
